

1/ The explanation for the name is quite interesting but it must be frustrating to have to change band's name 'cos of line up changes?!

Well the name change happened a long time ago, in 1995 to be exact so it is really no problem for us now. At the time of the name change we had two Demos out. So when we released two albums under the name Abaddon Incarnate it eclipses everything we done in the past.

2/ Without giving us the reason why the former members have left the band, can u tell us why this is happening unfortunetely in most of bands these days?!

Its hard to play in a underground band, it takes a lot of commitment and a willingness to work for little money. You cannot keep a mortgage on a house or build a career because the band is a long term commitment. Many people have not got the personality to commit to a project like a underground band and wimp out after a few years.

3/ You say that your music is heavier than before and call yourself a brutal Death Metal band but for what i heard I tend to classify your music into Grind with a Black Metal edge! What's your opinion 'bout such a judgement?!

I will say if that is your opinion, so be it. Our influences come from the likes of Morbid angel's first 2 CD's, Immolation, incantation, Deicide. As well as Napalm Death, Brutal Truth and Other shit like that. The only Black metal which as influenced us in any way would be Darkthrone's "A Blaze In The Northern Sky" and Immortals "Battles In The North" A lot of Black Metal fans liked our first Cd "The Last Supper" because it had a very demonic vibe off it. Whereas the same people did not like the second one "Nadir" because it was more of a grindcore sound. You got to download our Mp3's and make up your own mind.

4/ You don't seem to have much luck, have you thought about giving up or changing musical style?!

Fuck you! We are going from strength to strength. We have released two albums which have sold 5000 copies between them. We have toured all over Europe and Australia. We have survived 11 years. No I never think of giving up. I never heard of your Zine, have you ever thought of giving up? What a stupid question. We are releasing our Third CD now Entitled "The Dark Crusade" so we will see how people respond to that. Its style is a mix between the first CD and the Second. It was not a conscious decision the music just came out that way.

5/ you played with English masters Desecration, did it help you to get deals or recognition?!

We met some contacts on these tours, such as Curby from Obscene in the Cz Republic. We sold many CD's and Shirts. We met Dave Rotten from Xtrem records who is releasing our third CD on his label during the Spanish leg of that tour. But we were in contact with him beforehand so it was an opportunity to meet face to face and iron out some details.

6/ I lived in the UK 4 years and never saw u live, what makes u so underground?!

Well we do not live in the UK, we are in Ireland which contrary to many peoples warped ideas is not part of the British United Kingdom. We played one tour of the british Circuit as part of the desecration tour 2 gigs in Wales and 1 in London. Ireland is a isleland which is quite isolated from the rest of Europe. So it has been quite hard for us to tour as we need Boat prices and extra costs like that to get across the water. However we are able to draw some bigger crowds now and get these prices easier. So we will be in Europe a lot more. I would like to know where abouts in the UK you have lived?

7/Have u got a fan base n are u well accepted in the UK scene?!

No. we have some interested people in england but we really need to get across the water a bit more to build up our reputation. With our new album "The Dark Crusade" we will be touring extensively to support and promote this.

8/Since u changed name have u got more interest from the press?!

No. Because we changed our name 8 years ago and we have only got press as Abaddon Incarnate. The previous band was terrible.

9/ What would you say to a band taht thinks giving up and lost faith in their music?

It's a pity, because I find nothing more rewarding than playing in this band. I would never dream of giving it up.
