4/ Have you got a contract to make a new album shortly, was a girl the most interesting singer at the moment since every bands have a female singer now!

With dragonheart we have a multi deal album, but now we are looking to play some gigs before to write some new songs. The new album will be recorded next year... I know that there are a lot of bands with Female voice, but for us it's different cos we had a female voice in the past, for us it's back to the past...

5/ Have u advertised or you just knew some people around to try out first?

To introduce the new singer our record company made a little bit of advertising, internet is a good one too... now the shows do the rest...

6/ Will you work on new material with her or you will still play the most famous songs live? the fans like to hear their fav songs!

Actually we are playing a great show, with a lot of old songs and some from the last album, the first gig went really good, reaction from the crowd was really good! They like our old songs... When the tour will be over we'll start to write new songs, but in real old style.!

Hehehe, as I said, I hadn't much time to work on it, because I knew all too late! Of course in that week I studied as I could the songs for the try, and then yes, I went there thinking to myself: "Let's see how it goes!!"

4/ You have several bands, what are your commitments with them and are u ready to leave them behind if u tour and become the actual White Skull singer?

When I came into White Skull line up I had just one band active, that's Db Killer, some kind of bad hard rock. The other one (acoustic) was just a side project, never played live, so.. But I never thought to leave Db Killer as they're also good friends of mine. Unfortunately at the moment some health problems force me to make a choice, and I have to take a break with them.. they'll chose between waiting for me or going on their way, but I'll always understand their choice. As I said, we're very good friends..

5/ When Jason Newsted first replaced Cliff Burton many people hated him, what do you think WS fans would react, and most when the voice is changed unless u manage to get the same tunes?

And what about Paul Di Anno and Bruce Dickinson?? Hehe, I know, every change in one band is some kind of shock for fans, surely most if it's the singer. At the moment the first shows have gone very well, people were happy and I was much more! Of course some will miss the first singer Federica, I understand it, she was very charismatic, so she'll be never forgotten. But things happen and change, White Skull love their music and they didn't mean to stop playing, so the change was forced. We just hope to give a new and a little different energy to the band with the new line up.

6/ what's the pression on your shoulders?

7/ WS have quite a big name now so is it gonna a big press stuff for u? jumping from someone noone knows to someone known everywhere in this world?

Well, I honestly don't think about that. After all I just love heavy metal, I'm a metal fan to many bands too, and I just love singing this kind of music. This is my only thought. All the rest is just the outline and really nothing has changed in me.

8/ Does it have consequences on your job?

Not many at the moment, as I work in my own company with another person, so we're able to make shifts and I can have free days for the tour. Then, we'll see..

9/ Why haven't you chosen a Thrash metal band?

Nice question! I would have if I had found it! Haha. I love thrash metal and I had a couple of bay area-thrash bands that I loved so much. But people change and I don't know why (!!!), so line up crashed down both times, and some of them don't even play any more.. it's not easy to find thrashers in my town, so.. anyway I love thrash but heavy metal as well, so I'm very happy to be in White Skull band, as they are really true, and after all this is the most important attitude for me in metal: beeing TRUE.
